After a long hiatus the Committee will again meet to discuss the status of the remaining phases contemplated by the Stanley Avenue Recreation Master Site Plan and other pertinent issues. Please plan to attend.

NOTES

The Committee discussed the remaining Phases left to be completed of the Stanley Avenue Recreation Master Site Plan. Mr. Soriano reviewed the remaining Phases. Mr. Soriano noted that the only phase that the Borough could pursue for a development project would be Phase 3(b)-Demolition of old Playground building and construction of new basketball court. The other Phases, Phase 4-Renovations to the Community Pool Bathhouse and decking and Phase 8-Reconstruction of Dodson Ballfield will need additional preparation. For Phase 4, DCNR recommends a Pool Feasibility Study. The Borough has submitted a Grant application and is waiting to see if DCNR will approve it. Phase 8, the Borough will need to acquire additional land from the adjoining neighbors and is still negotiating the sale. DCNR had approved a Land Acquisition Grant in the amount of \$104,000. Phase 6, Construction of parking lot and Volleyball court is also not completed and the Borough will need to reassess whether it will fit in the scheme of things.

Committee reviewed the FH Playground Recreation Fund that has a balance of \$21,600(w/o last year's anticipated donation). Most of the money was raised through the efforts of events planned by the former Mayor Stephen Repasch. Committee discussed the potential use for the funds. Committee agreed to explore the development of Phase 3(a)-Demolish the old Playground building and construct a sand volleyball court. URDC to discuss concept with PITA(or staff) and formulate cost estimates for PITA Cmt. to review.. Committee also was favorable in using the Playground Funds(\$26,000) for future Operation and Maintenance. Mr. Rapp announced that the Borough will install security cameras at the playground.

Mr. Repasch announced that Maureen Lynch and Paul Balliet would be interested in serving on the Committee. Committee welcomed them as new members. Mr. Repasch will notify them of the appointment.

Committee will discuss other fundraising activities in association with the Exchange Club. (Calendars, Special Community Events).

Committee to start meeting regularly, at minimum twice a year. Next meeting will be the last Wed of November, 2008 at 6:30 p.m.
