RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 31

A RESOLUTION OF THE FOUNTAIN HILL BOROUGH, LEHIGH COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2021

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Fountain Hill, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania:

THAT a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real properties within the Borough of Fountain Hill subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2021 as follows:

SECTION 1. Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 9.13 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of \$0.913 on each one hundred dollars of assessed value.

SECTION 2. Tax rate for the Fire Department, the sum of 0.08 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of \$0.008 on each one hundred dollars of assessed value.

SECTION 3. Tax rate for Library Services, the sum of 0.40 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of \$0.040 on each one hundred dollars of assessed value.

SECTION 4. That any resolution, or part of resolution, conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR – Discussion on Non - Agenda Items

Ms. Halleman cited an article in The Morning Call that police officers in Allentown, Bethlehem and Easton are now equipped with body cameras. The article stated that Easton paid for its new cameras with a \$90,000 Department of Justice grant that was matched by the city. Ms. Halleman encouraged Chief Bachert to investigate the use of body cameras as well. Chief Bachert acknowledged while the cameras have many useful benefits, they also have the potential to unjustly invade an individual's right to privacy.

Mr. Mike Spencer of 1035 Jeter Ave congratulated Mr. Blatt on his nomination as Council President. As he commended Council and administration on the 2021 budget proposal holding property taxes steady, he asked to justify capital reserves and potentially decrease property taxes in the future. The Finance Director acknowledged the need for policy defining the level of the fund balance and also discouraged the use of general statements regarding fund balance levels.

Mr. Rich Rolen, the former Deputy Chief of the Fountain Hill Voluntary Fire Co., asked Council again to review his termination.
