- ❖ **Limit of four 32- gallon containers per week (2 bags yard waste may be substituted)**
- ❖ **Bags can not weigh over 25 pounds.**
- ❖ **Cans cannot weigh over 40 pounds.**
- ❖ **1 Bulk Item per week limit (Household items)**
Mattresses & box springs are considered bulk. Both must be wrapped in plastic.
- ❖ **No hazardous waste, or electronics**
